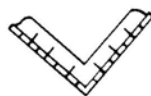

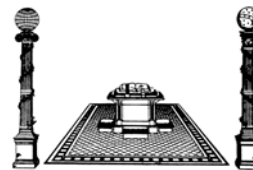


FROM THE SOUTH
