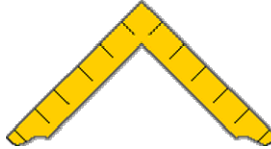

## MASON ON THE MOON

Brother Edwin (Buzz) Aldrin, Jr. (1930-) was an astronaut and the second man to walk on the moon. Despite the U.S. Postal Service regulation that a living person may not be shown on a postage stamp, there is no doubt that the people shown on this stamp are Neil Armstrong and Edwin Eugene Aldrin, Jr. However,



there is no way to specifically identify each of the figures on the stamp, so the postal regulation was not technically broken. Aldrin was initiated on February 17, and passed April 12, 1955 in Oak Park Lodge No. 864, Montgomery, Alabama. He received his Master Mason's degree on February 21, 1956 in Lawrence N. Greenleaf Lodge No. 169, Denver, Colorado. He then affiliated with Montclair Lodge No. 144, Montclair, New Jersey. When he made his trip to the moon, he carried a special deputation from the Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Texas. This document deputized Aldrin as the special representative of the Grand Master. It authorized him to open a representation of the Grand Lodge of Texas on the moon and establish Masonic territorial jurisdiction there for the Texas Grand Lodge. There is definitely no argument now with Texas on the question of Grand Lodge territorial size.

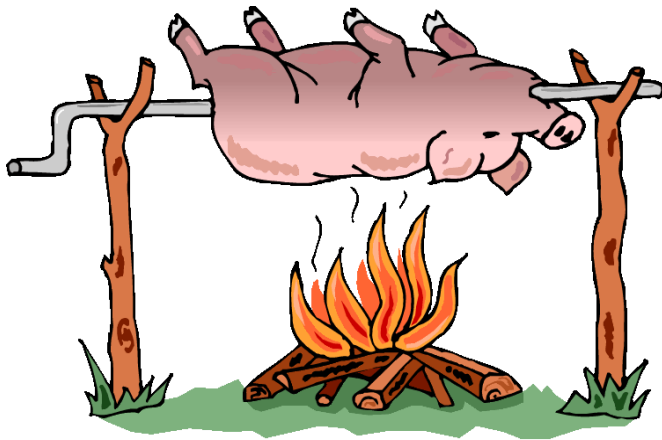

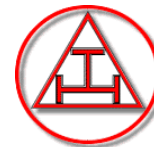
